Arittapatti village in Madurai recently notified as first biodiversity heritage site in Tamil Nadu.

- Arittapatti village is surrounded by a chain of seven barren granite hillocks that act as a
 watershed and support close to 72 lakes, 200 natural spring pools and three check dams.
 - The **Anaikondan lake** built during the reign of the **Pandyas** in the **16**th **century** is one among them.
- Flagship raptor species found in the region: Laggar Falcon, Shaheen Falcon and Bonelli's Eagle.
- The site also features various **megalithic structures**, **Tamil Brahmi Inscriptions**, **Jain Beds** and 2200-year-old rock-cut temples.
