### **About the river:**

- The Bhogdoi River is one of the **south bank tributaries** of the river Brahmaputra.
- It originates from **Mokokchung in Nagaland** where it is also known as **Tsujenyong nullah**.
- The river is flowing between Assam and Nagaland.
- The total catchment area of the inter-state river is 1,545 square kilometres and travels **160 kilometres before joining Dhansiri river** near its confluence with Brahmaputra.
