- The Bhogdoi River is one of the **south bank tributaries** of the river Brahmaputra.
- It originates from Mokokchung in Nagaland where it is also known as Tsujenyong nullah.
- The river is flowing between Assam and Nagaland.
- The total catchment area of the inter-state river is 1,545 square kilometres and travels **160** kilometres before joining Dhansiri river near its confluence with Brahmaputra.
