

About Gandhamardan Hills:

- The hill is located between the Balangir and Bargarh districts of Odisha, India.
- It is well known for medicinal plants.
- The hills have historical monuments such as the **Nrusinghanath temple** located on the northern slope and **Harishankar temple** on the southern side.
- Hiuen Tsang described the hill shrine as a Buddhist heritage site named **Parimalagiri** in his chronicles.
- Dasycarpa and one spider peucetia harishankarensis are endemic to this hill.
