



About Henley Passport Index:

- The Henley Passport Index is the original, authoritative ranking of all the world's passports according to the **number** of **destinations** their **holders** can **access without** a **prior visa**.
 - Visa is a document that is **issued** by **governments** to **foreigners** who want to come to their nation.
- The index is based on data from the **International Air Transport Association (IATA)**, the largest and, most accurate travel information database.
 - IATA is the trade association for the world's airlines, that represents airlines with 83% of total air traffic.
- The index was launched in 2006.
- It includes 199 different passports and 227 travel destinations.

Key findings of the Index:

- Singapore has secured the top rank in 2023 index.
 - It is now officially the most powerful passport in the world.
 - Its citizens can visit 192 travel destinations out of 227 around the world visa-free.


India's performance in Henley Passport Index:

- India secured 80th rank in Henley Passport Index 2023.
- Presently, Indian passport holders can arrive in **57 countries** without a prior visa.
- India had ranked 81 in 2021 and 87 in 2022.
- India now has visa-free access to 57 destinations worldwide.

About Henley Openness Index:

- It measures how many nations does a country allow visa-free access to.
- India was ranked 94 out of a total of 97 ranks for allowing only four countries visa-free access.
- Afghanistan, North Korea, Papua New Guinea, and Turkmenistan scored zero for not permitting visa-free access for any passport.
- Top 20 most open countries are all small island nations or African states, except for Cambodia.
- There are 12 completely open countries that offer visa-free or visa-on-arrival entry to all 198
 passports in the world.
 - Those 12 countries are: Burundi, Comoro Islands, Djibouti, Guinea-Bissau, Maldives, Micronesia, Mozambique, Rwanda, Samoa, Seychelles, Timor-Leste, and Tuvalu.

Importance of visa free entry agreements:

• A visa-free agreement is a **symbol** of **trust** between **two** countries, where both countries can reap the **social** and **economic benefits** of **open** borders.



• It can foster **cooperation** and **trade**, and improve international relations.
