India joins Executive Committee of Codex Alimentarius Commission

India was recently **elected** unanimously **as a member** representing the Asian region in the **Executive Committee of Codex Alimentarius Commission (CAC)** during its 46th meeting.

About the Codex Alimentarius Commission (CAC):

- It was **jointly created by FAO** (Food and Agriculture Organization) and **WHO** (World Health Organization), as the most important **international body** in the field of **food standards**.
- Codex developed many internationally recognized standards, guidelines, codes of practice, and defined permitted levels of additives, contaminants, and chemical residues in food.
- The end goal: Ensure food is safe for everyone, everywhere.
- Meetings: Regular session once a year alternating between Geneva and Rome.
- Funded by: Regular budgets of WHO and FAO after approval of their governing bodies.
- **Members**: 188 Member Countries including India, and 1 Member Organization (European Union).

About Executive Committee of CAC:

- **Function:** Management of CAC's programme of standards development by conducting a critical review of proposals and monitoring progress of standards development.
- **Composition**: A Chair, three vice Chairs, six regional coordinators, and seven elected representatives from the various geographical regions of Codex.

Significance for India:

- India would get an opportunity to contribute to the **International standard-setting process** for different food product categories and get involved in the **decision-making process**.
- India's proposal for setting up **group and global standards for millets** was accepted by CAC and supported by the member countries.
- The **Indian delegation** consisted of members from:



- FSSAI (Food Safety and Standards Authority of India),
- · Ministry of Health and Family Welfare,
- · NIFTEM (National Institute of Food Technology, Entrepreneurship and Management),
- APEDA (Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority),
- EIC (Export Inspection Council).
