Director General Postal Services has recently inaugurated **first** Permanent Aadhaar Enrolment Centre (**PAEC**) for Army through **Army Postal Service**.

About the PAEC services:

- The **PAEC** will facilitate **Aadhaar related services** such as **enrolment** and **updation** for **tri-services personnel** (Defence & civil) and their **dependents** through their **Field Post Offices** (FPO).
- The expansion of this service through more **FPOs** will help facilitate **troops** to get user friendly **government service** in their **vicinity**.
- This service will be provided in **48 locations** in the country.
 - These 48 PAEC will be functional in both Field and Peace locations.
- All Command Headquarters (HQs), Corps HQs and selected FPOs has to **establish** PAEC services.
- Department of Posts (DoP) and Unique Identification Authority of India (**UIDAI**) have provided **training**, **equipment's** and **tech support**.

About the Army Postal Service:

- The Army Postal Service (APS) is a government-operated military mail system in India.
- They are **subsidized** to ensure that **military mail** posted between **duty stations abroad** and the **home country** (or vice versa) does **not** cost the sender more than normal domestic mail traffic.
- It was established in 1856.
- Headquarters: Sena Dak Bhawan, Delhi
- Badge: consists of a flying swan (Raj Hans) encased by a wheat stalk wreath in a semi-oval shape.
 - The words 'Mail-Milap' ('union through mail') and 'Sena Dak Seva' in Hindi are embodied on scrolls in the badge.
- Officers are deputed from the Indian Postal Service and from the Army Corps.



• Army Postal Service is the **only** service that enables **civil service officers** to work in the **armed forces**.

Activities of Army Postal Service:

- The Army Postal Service provides **Postal**, **Remittance**, **Savings** & **Insurance** services to Army, Indian Navy, Air Force and Paramilitary forces personnel.
- It also provides services to Indian troops deployed with United Nations Peace Keeping Forces abroad.
