- National Safe Motherhood Day is an initiative undertaken by the White Ribbon Alliance.
- The government of India in 2003 designated 11 April as National Safe Motherhood Day.
- The day also marks the birth anniversary of Kasturba Gandhi.
- Aim: To raise awareness about the care that a pregnant woman needs before, during, and after childbirth.
- SDG (Sustainable Development Goal) target 3.1: reduce global maternal mortality ratio (MMR) to less than 70 per 100 000 live births by 2030.
