About the Nordic Baltic Eight (NB8):

- The Nordic Baltic Eight (**NB8**) is a **regional cooperation** of **8 countries**, that collaborates for **innovation** in technology.
- 8 Member countries- Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Iceland, Latvia, Lithuania, Norway and Sweden.

Significance:

- It collectively represents an **economy** of more than **USD 2.012 trillion** with a population of just above **27 million**.
- Nordic countries have a higher GDP (Gross domestic product) per capita and rank high in the Human Development Index.
 - The **Nordic nations** are Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Finland, and Iceland, as well as the Faroe Islands, Greenland, and Åland.
- Nordic countries rank high in Human Development Index (Norway-2nd, Iceland- 4th, Sweden -7th, Denmark- 6th, Finland- 11th).
- Nordic countries are leaders in innovation, clean technology, renewable energy, and sustainability.
- Baltic countries are leaders in IT (Information technology), digitization, cyber technology, and green technology.
 - The **Baltic nations** are Denmark, Sweden, Finland, Russia, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, and Germany.

Key facts on Relations of India-Nordic-Baltic Region:

- India-Nordic interactions gained momentum with the establishment of India-Nordic Framework.
- India's combined trade in goods with NB8 countries was US \$ 8.036 billion in 2021-22.
- The cumulative FDI (Foreign Direct Investment) received from NB8 countries from April 2000 to



December 2022 is US \$ 4.307 billion.

- India-EU FTA (Free trade agreement) and India-EFTA (European Free Trade Association) TEPA (Trade and Economic Partnership Agreement) negotiations are in process.
- India's engagement includes specific partnerships such as-
 - The India-Denmark Green Strategic Partnership
 - India-Norway Task Force on Blue Economy
 - Sustainability and ICT cooperation with Finland
 - 'LeadIT' (Leadership for Industry Transition) initiative with Sweden
 - Sustainability and Digital Partnership with Finland
 - Geothermal cooperation with Iceland
 - · E-governance and cybersecurity with Estonia
