About Norman Peterson Pritchard:

Early Life and Background

- Norman Pritchard was born on January 23, 1875, in Calcutta (now Kolkata) during British India.
- He was actively involved in athletics, football, and acting.

Olympic Journey:

- Norman Pritchard participated in the 1900 Paris Olympics.
- He won two silver medals in the 200-metre sprint and 200-metre hurdles.
- He was the First Asian-born athlete to win an Olympic medal.
- He only represented India in the Olympics after participating with an Indian passport and birth certificate.

Achievements and Records:

- Norman Pritchard was the First Olympian to act in Hollywood, under the screen name Norman Trevor.
- He scored a hat-trick in an official football match on Indian soil in 1897.
- He won Bengal province's **100-yard sprint title** for **seven consecutive years** (1894-1900).

Identity and National Representation:

- He was officially listed as an **Indian athlete** by the **International Olympic Committee**.
 - However, British historians suggest his medals should be credited to **Great Britain**.
- India's first official Olympic team was named after becoming a member of the International Olympic Committee in February 1920.
