About APAAR:

- APAAR stands for Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry.
- It aims to establish a unified student identity system called 'One Nation, One Student ID'.
- It provides a unique and permanent 12-digit ID to every student.
 - The ID incorporates all academic achievements of the student in one place.
- It reduces fraud and duplicate educational certificates by providing a single, trusted reference for educational institutions.
- Approximately 25 crore APAAR IDs have already been created.
- APAAR aligns with the National Education Policy (NEP) of 2020 and the National Credit and Qualifications Framework (NCrF).

What is the Academic Bank of Credits?

- It is like a digital storage where students can avail its benefits.
- In this digital credit bank, all the marks/credits scored by the students will be stored.
- Personal information of students is also stored here.
