About Colombo Security Conclave (CSC):

- CSC started as a trilateral maritime cooperation mechanism among India, Maldives, and Sri Lanka in 2011.
- It was **stalled after 2014** due to tensions but **revived in 2020**, and **expanded** to include **Mauritius**, **Seychelles**, and **Bangladesh**.
- It demonstrates India's evolving strategic vision for the multipolar Indian Ocean.
- It institutionalizes India's **role**, shaping **regional security**, and addressing existing and emerging **threats**.

CSC's Focus:

- Maritime security and safety,
- Counter-terrorism,
- Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief, and
- Drug trafficking control.
