About Ural River:

- The Ural River, **2,428 km long**, flows through **Russia and Kazakhstan**, marking the continental divide between **Europe and Asia**.
- Known as the **Zhayyq River** in Kazakh, it originates in Russia's Ural Mountains near Mount Kruglaya and empties into the **Caspian Sea**, the largest inland sea worldwide.
- The river's digitate delta is a significant feature as it enters the Caspian Sea, resembling a tree-like structure.
- **Permanent monuments** with "Europe" and "Asia" engraved on them flank the Ural River bridge in Orenburg, Russia, symbolizing the continental boundary.
- The Ural is the third-longest river in Europe, trailing only the Volga and Danube rivers.
- The river's journey from the Ural Mountains to the Caspian Sea spans two continents.
